

# Year 1 – maths learning

## Activities to do at home 2

... with raffle tickets!



**Take out strips of raffle tickets.** This could be numbers 1 – 5, 1 – 10, 1 – 20 or beyond, depending on your child’s starting point.

**Find:** the ticket for their age, your door number and other numbers of personal significance.

**Matching:** ask them to find and match each ticket, saying the number as they match it ... here is a 3, here is the other 3!

Match the tickets to objects counted.

**Order, find and say:** practise placing the tickets in number order, start with 1 – 5, then to 10 etc. Ask them to find you a given number e.g. ‘please find me the number thirteen’. Can they find other ‘teen’ numbers?

Select a number and ask one more or one less e.g. what is 1 **less than** 8? (If unsure remind them it is the **counting number before.**)

*Counting saying ‘more’ and ‘less’ can really help too...e.g. 1 and 1 more is 2. 2 and 1 more is 3. Etc. Or 10 and 1 less is 9, 9 and one less is 8 etc.*

Take 5 tickets e.g. 6, 3, 10, 9, 7 ask your child to place them in order from the smallest to the largest.

**Practise copying / writing numbers:** 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10

**Write the words** – one, two, three, four, and five – read, say and match the words to their raffle ticket. Just try one a day and build up. (By the end of Yr1 they should read and write numbers from 1-20 in numerals and words).
