#### <u>Game 1- What number am I?</u>

You will need number cards up to 10 or 20 these can be on paper.

The game starts with the two players facing each other. Each person selects a numbered card and sticks it on their forehead, so the other player can see.

The other player will ask questions to try and guess their own number such as... Is my number more than 5? Is my number a 2 digit number?

### <u>Game 2- Order numbers</u>

You will need number cards up to 10 or 20 these can be on paper. Put all number cards in a bowl pick a number and each person takes turns to pick a number and put it in a number line.

#### <u>Game 3 – Number hunt</u>

## <u>Game 4 - How many?</u>

Get a jar and some household objects such as buttons, pennies or stones. One person will need to put the objects into the jar one by one and the other will need to close their eyes and count how many is in the jar.
