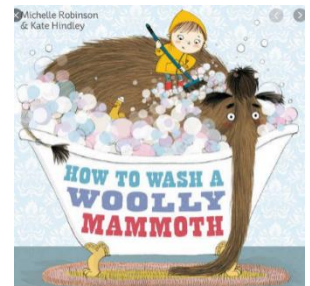


This week in Year 3 we are looking at instructions – we are focusing on the book how to wash a woolly mammoth.

How to wash a woolly mammoth



Does your woolly mammoth need a wash? It's not a very easy thing to do...

Woolly mammoths are quite BIG and wool is notoriously tricky to clean. Don't worry, just follow this step-by-step guide.

1. Fill the bath tub. If your mammoth is feeling thirsty, this may take a while.
2. Add bubbles.
3. Add mammoth, you may need to use a broom, a spooky mask, a skateboard or a heavy-duty crane but if all else fails there is always cake.
4. Start scrubbing! Don't forget to wash behind those ears.
5. Wash his big, fat tummy but be careful a mammoth's tummy is terribly tickly!
6. Make a big splash!
7. Now for the really woolly bit. You're to need some shampoo but not too much in case you get any in the mammoths... eyes!
8. Let him share a bath with YOU!
9. Throw in the towel and snuggle.
