
This week in Year 3 we are looking at instructions — we are focusing on the book how to wash a woolly mammoth.

How to wash a woolly mammoth



Does your woolly mammoth need a wash? It's not a very easy thing to do...

Woolly mammoths are quite BIG and wool is notoriously tricky to clean. Don't worry, just follow this step-by-step guide.

- 1. Fill the bath tub. If your mammoth is feeling thirsty, this may take a while.
- 2. Add bubbles.
- 3. Add mammoth, you may need to use a broom, a spooky mask, a skateboard or a heavy-duty crane but if all else fails there is always cake.
- 4. Start scrubbing! Don't forget to wash behind those ears.
- 5. Wash his big, fat tummy but be careful a mammoth's tummy is terribly tickly!
- 6. Make a big splash!
- 7. Now for the really woolly bit. You're to need some shampoo but not too much in case you get any in the mammoths... eyes!
- 8. Let him share a bath with YOU!
- 9. Throw in the towel and snuggle.
