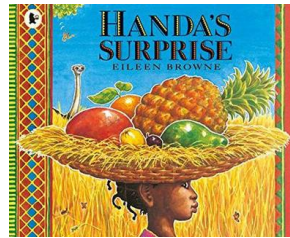


English

To support children as writers, our learning is often based around a story book. The last book the children read in Reception was called Handa's Surprise. Here is a link to the book on You Tube

Watch the story together.

Turn off the sound and read the story together.

Can the children re-tell the story? There is a support sheet with pictures on the Year 1 page.

Can the children draw a picture and write a sentence about the story? There is a support sheet on the Year 1 page but writing on any paper you have is great in supporting writing development. Please follow the handwriting guidance on the Year 1 page to help with children forming each letter correctly. Children at this stage are encouraged to sound out words and write the sounds they hear, give them lots of praise if they do this. If your child is struggling to write anything then ask them to say a sentence for you to write, can they copy your sentence?

Physical Education – we are learning about improving our personal physical ability. How many hops can you do in half a minute? Can you improve on this over the week?
