Masks in School

We are currently asking for all adults entering the school site to wear masks.

All staff are wearing masks in school when moving around.

Communicating with Teachers

We have asked for parents NOT to congregate outside of classroom doors. If you would like to speak to a Teacher please email info@parkgate.coventry.sch.uk with your query/concern. This will then be passed to the required Teacher.

Ventilation

As per the latest Government guidance, windows and doors must remain open to ensure airflow through classrooms.

As we move into the colder months, we are advising that children wear additional layers underneath their uniform to keep them warm. This will continue to be monitored and reviewed regularly.

Symptoms of Coronavirus

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)

a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)

a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Please remember to keep us informed if your child, or anybody in your household, has symptoms or is being tested for Coronavirus.
